

CLEAN UP FOR THE GREAT CAMPAIGN

Who can understand his errors? Cleanse me from secret faults. (Psalm 19:12). Create in me a clean heart O God and renew a stedfast spirit within me. (Psalm 51:10)

It was after a soul stirring, inspiring week of spiritual meetings that thoughts were left behind in the minds of us christian, we kept wondering is it better to be Dusted or Cleansed? And this life takes no cheap clean up.

Spiritually, as christians we have to realize that the more we appear beneath the light of God's word it is the more clearly the flaws in our lives are revealed. No wonder the Psalmist after his deep survey had come to the realization that sin really has its hidden nature and so he wrote "Cleanse me from secret faults". Sometimes we don't believe that sins lying beneath surface need to be cleansed.

"Jane at 5 years old didn't like to be bathed by her mom especially when she gets real dirty and mom would use the soap and water to scrub those hard-to-get-at places on her body. One day as they both reasoned, her mom asked, "Jane darling don't you want to be clean? "Yes mom," she whimpered but can't you dust me instead?"

In the realm of spirituallity we must realize that a Sunday morning dusting by going to Church and confessing our outward sins is easier, but it won't work!!! We have to allow ourselves a daily discipline of letting God's spirit show us from the word what needs to be confessed because if God was to look an eaiser way out to save mankind where would you and I be today? Would there be anyplace fit enough for us?

As christians when we take short cuts the inner filth remains undisturbed in our lives. (He who is not concerned about his secret faults will sooner or later reveal serious character flaws.)

"A wealthy business man once hired a handyman to clean up his yard, the handyman replied, Sir it would cost you an amount of \$50.00 per hour and a job like this will take approximately three to four days. The business man then realized that this was a few thousand dollars clean up efforts and this bill would take sometime to pay and that bill sounded extremely high."

Often times we as christians run into the same dilemma in our lives, and so we just sit there and allow the stench of sin to pollute us, but we must realize this deserves no cheap clean up even though we finally recognize the seriousness of the problem the clean up seems too expensive but it never is, it always worth the effort and the cost.

I have grown to realize that living with unconfessed sin in my life reveals that I don't recognize how much God hates sin. We need to sing like the singers of old "No sin is too small to avoid". Let's also agree with the word of God that sin is wrong. 1st John 1:9.

Finally, please, no cleaning up of sins pollution is cheap but its worth it.

Remember also, confessing your sins is no substitute for forsaking them.

THE HUMAN AND DIVINE NATURE OF JESUS

How could he have been John when John was just a little older than he was. John had baptised him? and Jesus was around when John was beheaded? All things taken into consideration if he was Essias - a prophet of renown (Elijah) who called down fire from heaven and slew thousands of Baal's prophets, was later taken up into Heaven by a fiery chariot, why then did not the world repent at being given a second chance to have Elijah saved them? He being a man that had gone to and return -ed from Heaven?

Today, people are still confused! Yes! you guessed it, they choose to be so. It suits their Adamic nature to always accept that which is evil. I am convinced as I go from Day to Day that many Trinitarians will not accept that Jesus is indeed God. They baulk and ridicule the oneness Doctrine and rationalise that we, the Unitarians, are irrational. So many times I have sat back and watch our Ministers of Government holding dual Ministeries and Portfolios, many Trinitarian Hiechary holds dual Offices but they fail to credit Jesus with the same ability. They fail to believe that the Creator of mankind could take on Flesh.

It is inconceivable to think that the learned men of Today, hinged a misdeed on one single verse of Scripture, which when examined cannot be and should not be misunderstood. It is inconceivable that the learned men of today, so eloquent and so much an authority on the Bible, cannot recognise that at the time the Bible was translated, by the then English Scholars, it was precise to a point in so much that they spoke of 'Such an one' - rather than saving that which we now know to be proper English - 'Such a one.' The rule at that time, without any exception was that when a word begins with a vowel it takes the article "AN". The same applied when the subject was a compound one, there was no need to repeat the subject: As in the

case of Matthew 28 verse 19, "Baptising them in the NAME of the father, and of the son, and of the Holy Ghost . . . "The co-ordinating conjuction -"And" could only have been used if the name of the father was of the son and the Holy Ghost.

It is inconceivable to think that highly spiritual men and women of Today do not know what is a proper noun from what is a common noun. Must we accept it that we can name our children 'father' and 'Son' and 'Holy Ghost? Must we understand that our banks will accept cheques drawn in these Names? and how then will we differentiate one from another?

It is inconceivable to think that the Apostle Peter willfully and knowingly disobeyed Jesus. What of the great Apostle and Missionary, Paul whose letters are read frequently and acclaimed living Epistles to the churches today and whose life every christian exemplifies? Did they baptise in 'Father, son and Holy Ghost? No my friends. They could do no such thing as the Jews and Romans alike were devout men to Learning and Knowledge. They would have done what the Lord Jesus had commanded.

The irony of it all is they pray in his name. Heal in his name, sing about his name but refuse to baptise in it. If the name is so powerful that it heals, why then cannot they Baptise in it? Again the answer is they refuse to do this.

This would be a public admission that they had been wrong in the first instance. And it appears that it is a crime beyond forgiveness to be wrong or to admit being wrong.

But I am afraid that many people are sadly mistaken in the notion that Baptism in Jesus name is wrong. The Bible supports only the baptism in Jesus name. Should we then not follow as the Apostle did? If we must condemn this baptism then we shall have to condem all the precepts, commandments and promises contained in the Bible.

Jesus was indeed God in the flesh, his was a dual nature, for a limited time only. He had a self inflicted duty to perform and as long as it had to be done he wore the 'house' of his own creation to do this Job.

If we understand his dual nature then we will understand why it is important that we revered the name of Jesus. The Bible declares that we should do ALL things in the name of Jesus. Not some If there is no other name given under heaven whereby men must be saved, if at the name of Jesus every knee shall bow and every tongue confess. Should we not bow?

The book of John declared that "He came unto his own, and his own received him not, he had made the world knew him not, Can man whom God created have so little regard for him? Did not Jesus say to Philip: "Have I been so long a time with you yet you have not known me Philip."

Truth is always staring us in the face but, as is our nature we never stop long enough to see it but is always ready to believe a lie. Nevertheless, God has a set time in which he will judge the world There are some rationale questions that need to be addressed to the rationale (1) Why did the angels say "For he shall save HIS people from their sins? (2) Why did Isaiah say the mighty God? (3) Why is it that Jesus is coming back for his people (4) Will there really be silence in Heaven, why, would Jesus be so tactless as to take the entire heavenly host with him?

There are two words which seem to get mixed up in the minds of some young people: Lust and Love. Some find it hard to distinguish between these. But these words are poles apart - as far as the East is from the West. Someone had helpfully said. "Love can wait but lust can't." Think on that for a while. You will see that there are oceans of truth in it.

Some questions. Is it love to mash up a girl's life? Do you pay her school fee give her a baby

and cause her to leave school? How do you feel to hear her say 'Look what mi come to?" Answer me Sir! Is it love to take away another woman's husband and cause her children to lack food and clothing? How do you feel to hear her say, "The same knife that stick sheep will stick goat too?" Answer me miss! But let's hear the flip-side of that record.
